

## Sports Premium Funding 2021-2022

The PE and Sport Premium is designed to help children get an active start in life, supporting primary schools to improve the quality of their PE and sport provision so that pupils experience the benefits of regular exercise – from becoming healthier both mentally and physically to improved behaviour and better academic achievement.

This academic year The Spires Academy will receive approximately £16,840 in Sports Premium. This will used in its entirety to fund 3 days of specialist PE/health and wellbeing from GLK Academies. Each primary class will receive  $2\frac{1}{2}$  hours of PE, and support with all aspects of health and wellbeing (including mental health), every week. This will be delivered by the same consistent member of staff, who is attached to the school. GLK have their own COVID-19 Risk Assessments, which can be found on their website.



The cost of this provision is £150 per day, so based on a 39 week academic year and 3 days per week the total cost will be £17,550. Shortfall to be made up from school curriculum budget.
